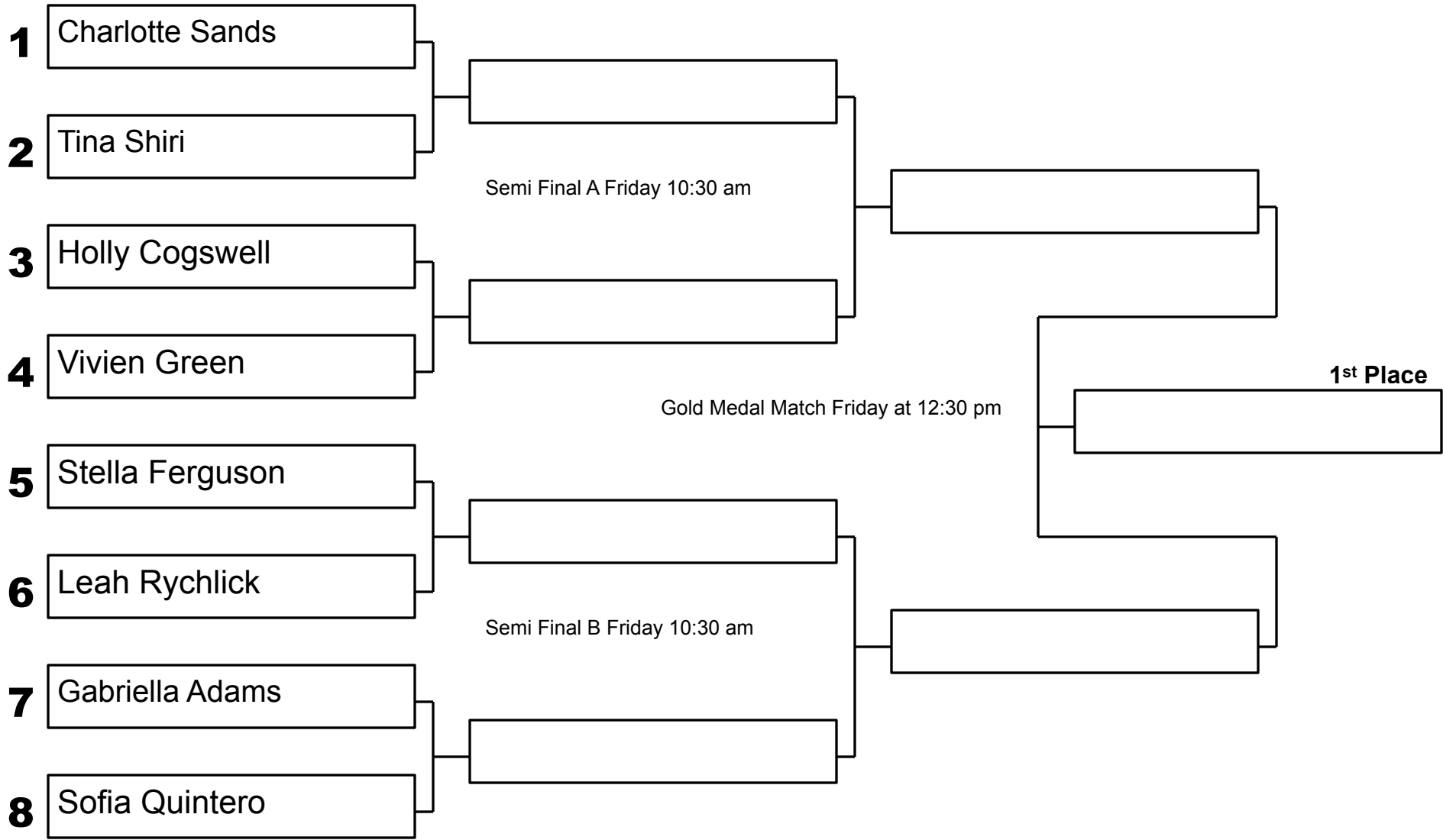

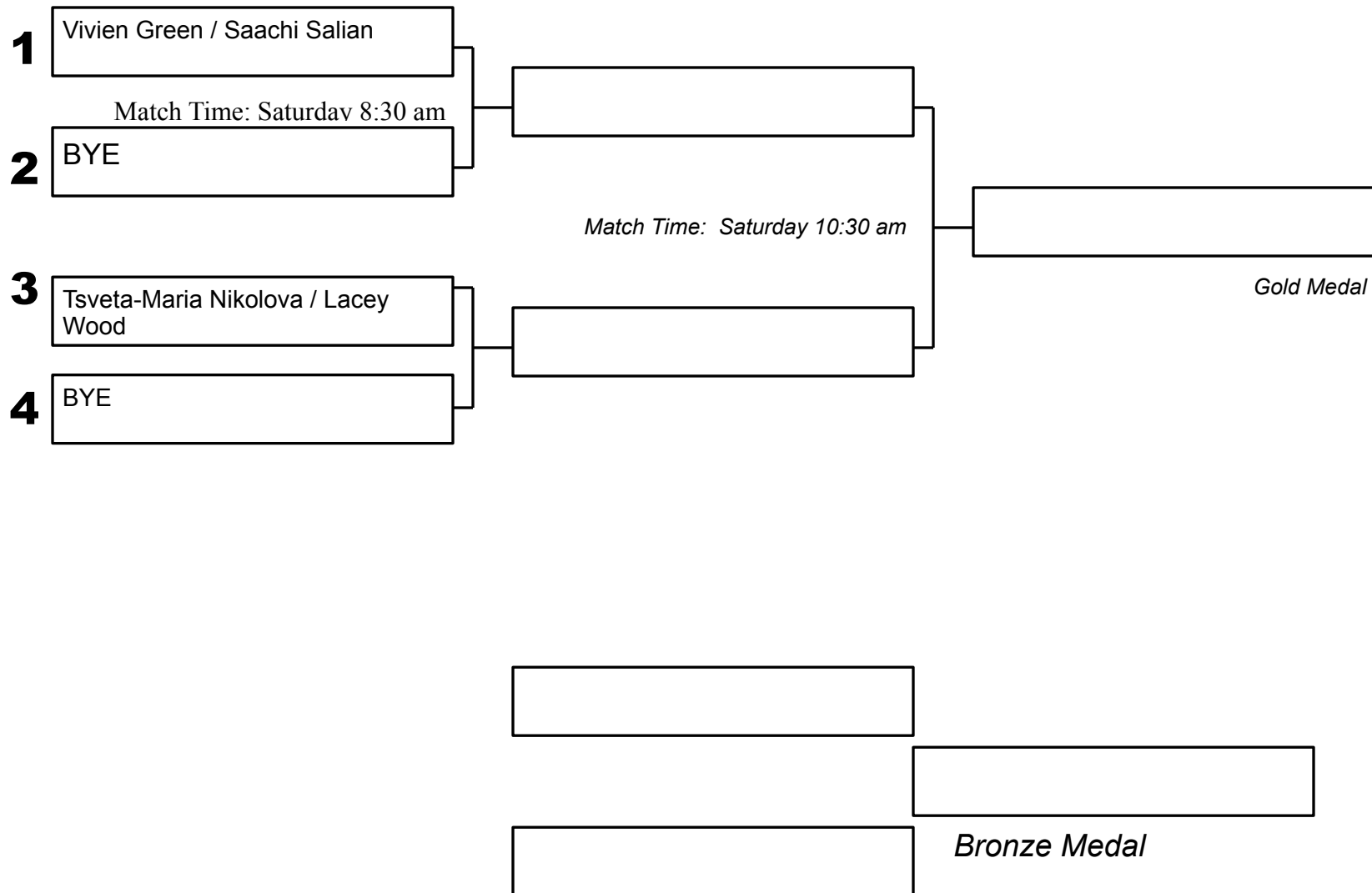

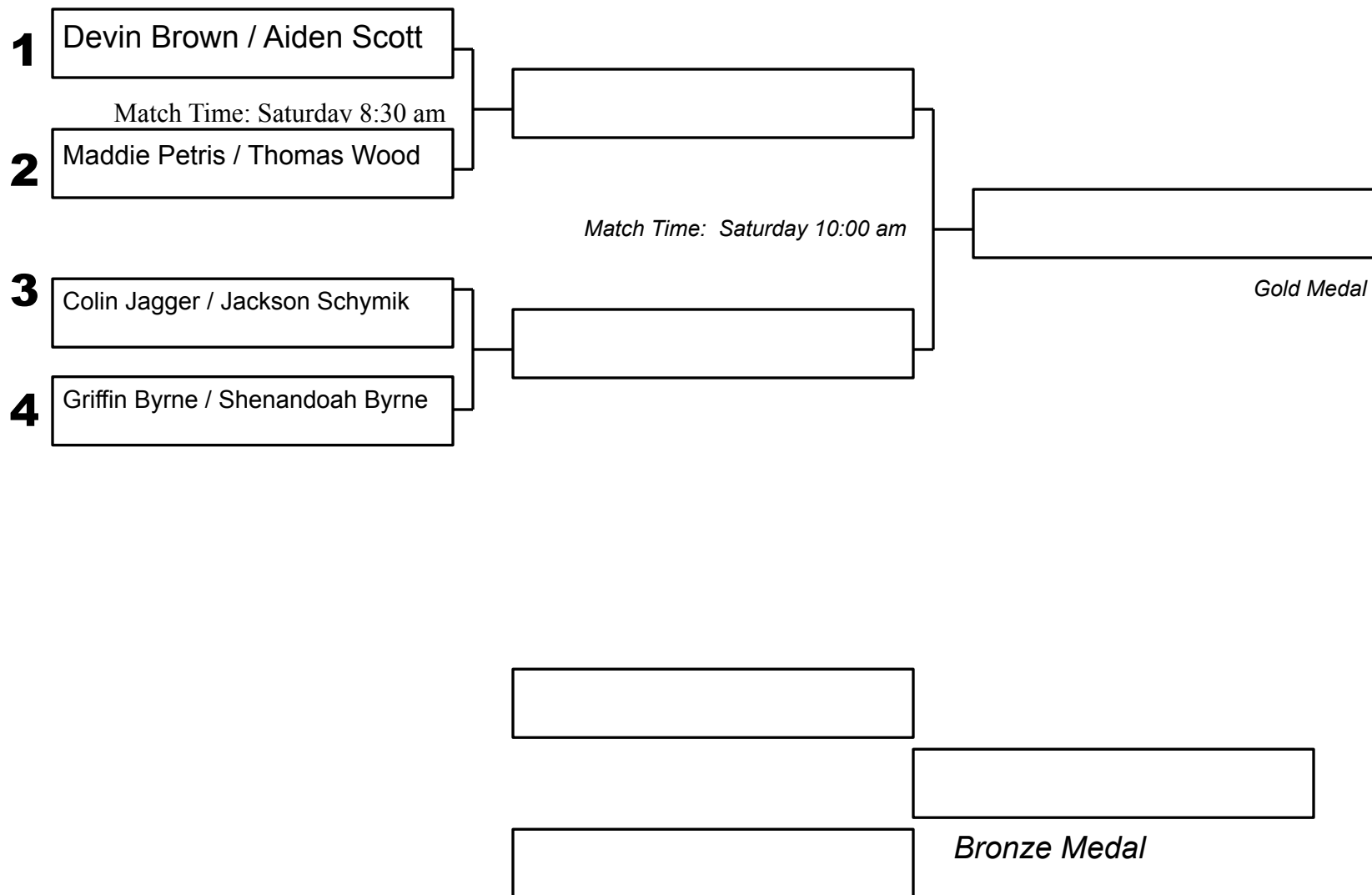
## Girls Doubles
